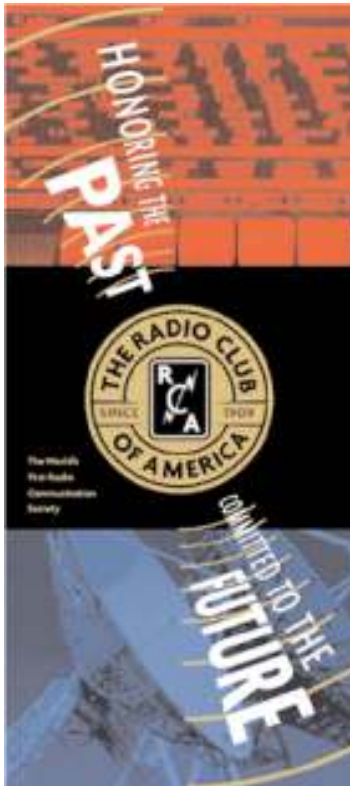

9:00 pm - 11:59 pm ET -- 75 meters

Frequencies for the bands are as follows:

15 meters: 21290-21315 kHz

20 meters: 14215-14250 kHz

40 meters: 7215-7240 kHz

75 meters: 3840-3875 kHz
