RCA, AWA and ARCI Archives Accepted By Smithsonian Institution & IEEE Library

The digital collections of the Radio Club of America, Antique Wireless Association and the Antique Radio Club of Illinois were submitted as a group to the Smithsonian Institution with the approval of each of their Boards of Directors earlier this year. These three important radio archives were accepted into the Smithsonian's permanent collections in July. They will be housed in Andover, Maryland at the Smithsonian Institution Libraries Research Annex in the Science and Technology collections. Davison receives the Centenarian Award

Charles Davison Sr. K2DOV turned 100 on October 8 and was presented with the RCA Centenarian Award in New Jersey by RCA President Vivian A Carr accompanied by RCA member, Don Vaughan, while attending a special birthday luncheon celebration hosted by his son, Charles Davison Jr. K2DPS. Davison Sr is only the fourth RCA member to receive this prestigious award (two have been awarded this years alone). Both Davison's have been RCA members since 1971, and the senior Davison became a Fellow in 1977.

Dr. Ted Rappaport Receives Award

UT ECE professor [Dr. Ted Rappaport](#) has been named the recipient of the 2011 IET Sir Monty Finniston Award for Achievement in Engineering and Technology. He will receive the award, which includes a medal, at a ceremony to be held in London on Nov. 9, 2011. The honor is one of the most prestigious given by the IET (formerly IEE), one of the world's leading professional societies for the engineering and technology community. IET has more than 150,000 members in 127 countries with offices in Europe, North America and Asia-Pacific. The Sir Monty Finniston Award is one of nine annual Achievement medals awarded by the IET, and recognizes the achievement of a single individual across all fields of Engineering and Technology.
